(in digital **photograph** format - .jpeg is preferred – no larger than 2MB each). No videos please.
- No people permitted within photos. Entry only (ie. Pet, project, gardening, etc.)
- We encourage you to challenge 3 others to participate in the Online Abernethy Fair!
- July 31st is the deadline. Photos will begin being posted Tuesday, August 4th

Please send photo submissions (up to 15 total), along with:

- Name of Exhibitor
- Subject of each photograph
- Town/City
- Age, if comfortable disclosing

How to Send Submissions

- You can email photos and information to the Ag Society Secretary @ abernethyag@gmail.com
- Please do NOT send photos/submissions via FaceBook.
- You can send your photos from a laptop, desktop, tablet, or even a cell phone!
- If you are unable to send or take photos on your own, get help from a family member or friend within your circle of close contacts to come over with a cell phone. Ensure to not endanger your health or safety. Remember to distance yourself at least 6 feet (2 meters) from one another and wash your hands often for a minimum of 20 seconds with soap and water.

By submitting any content (photos, your name, age, town, description of photo) to the Abernethy Agricultural Society (AAS), in any format or delivery style, you are thereby consenting to permit the AAS to publicly post said content on the AAS Facebook Page and the AAS's official website. You are also agreeing that AAS bears no responsibility if someone copies the photos from Facebook or the website for their own use.
